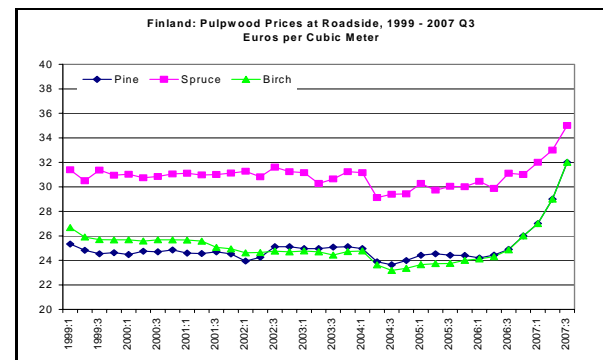

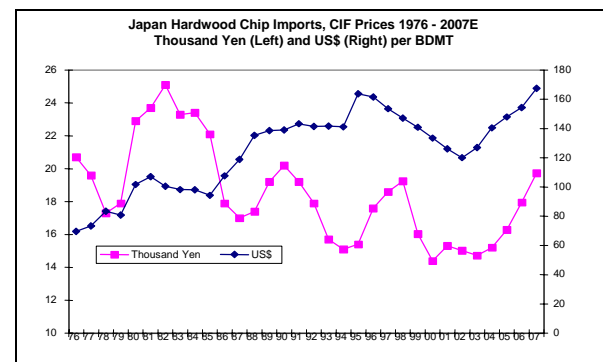

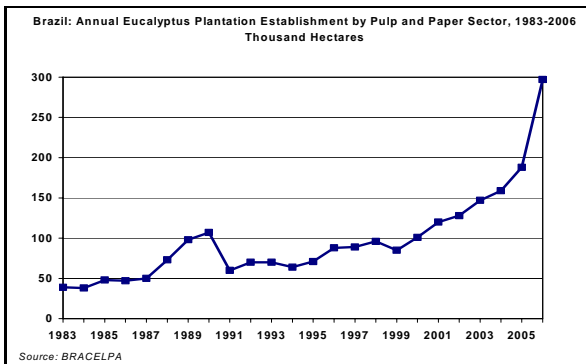


Finland pulpwood prices: Impact of Russian export tax?

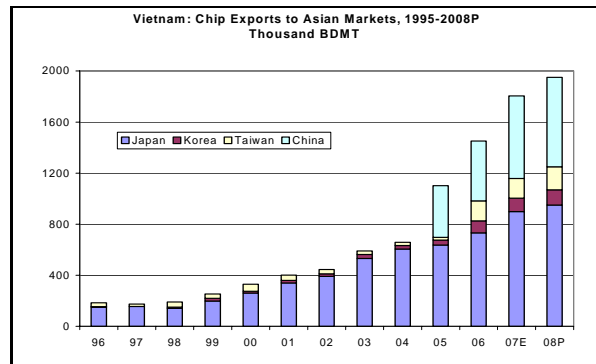


Nominal prices for imported hardwood chips in Japan hit record levels in 2007.

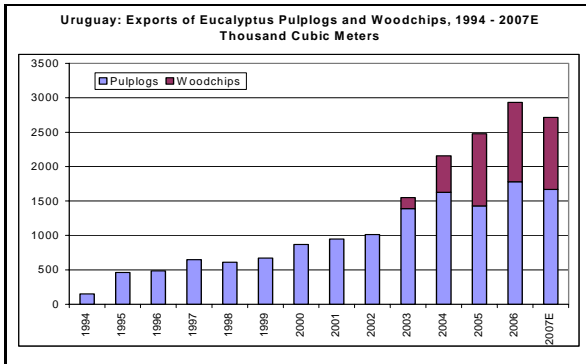

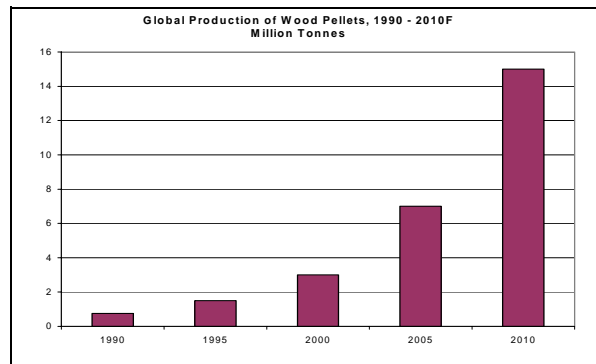
Surge in new eucalyptus planting signals Brazilian plans for pulp expansion.
